Editor: Michael Billiau has been nominated & excepted the position.

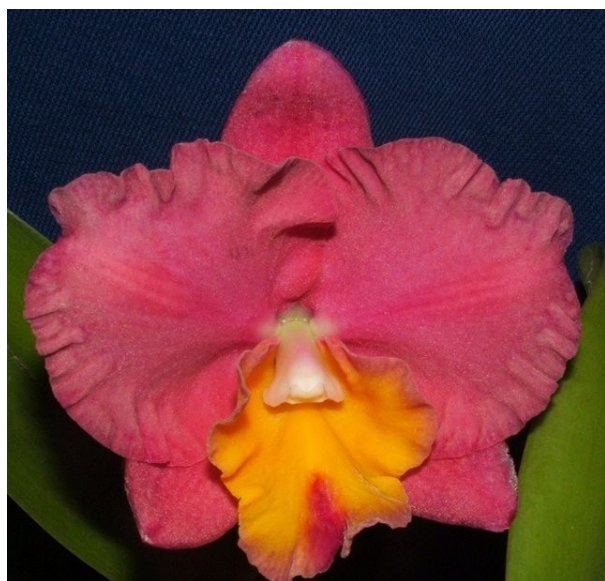
Show Secretary: Peter Rice has been nominated & excepted the position.
